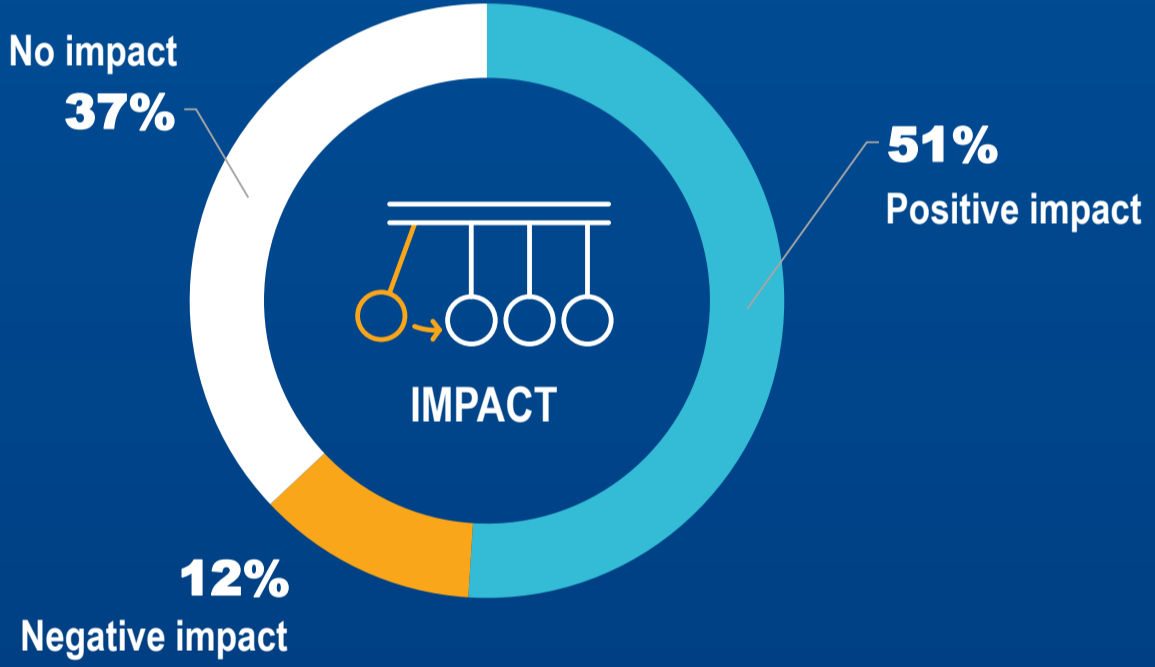
### MAIN REASONS FOR (CONSIDERING) A RELOCATION
